Should I, as a Polo Member purchase, lease or sponsor a horse and board this horse on Horse Park property, I understand and accept that I *must* become a full member of the Horse Park at Woodside.

THE HORSE PARK AT — WOODSIDE – General Agreement & Release of Liability

(Must be a Parent or Guardian if person named I, above is under the age of 18), hereby acknowledge that I have requested permission to participate in equestrian or other activities on the premises of The Horse Park at Woodside. I have read and agree to abide by the Horse Park Facility Use Rules. I am aware that combined training and eventing, jumping, trail riding, conditioning, polo and all other forms of equestrian activities, including the teaching, training or coaching thereof can be hazardous. I am voluntarily participating in equestrian or other activities with the knowledge of the danger involved and herby agree to accept any and all risks of injury or death. In consideration for being permitted to use the facilities at the Horse Park at Woodside, I hereby agree that I, my heirs, my distributees, guardians, legal representatives and assignees will not make a claim against, sue, attach the property of, or prosecute the *Horse Park at Woodside*, its landlord, directors, officers, members, employees or assignees, for any claim I now have or may hereafter have for death, injury or property damage resulting from my use of the facilities at the Horse Park at Woodside, whether caused by my acts of omission or negligence or any else's. In addition, it is understood that any and all insurance that I have shall be primary. To the fullest extent permitted by law, I shall defend, indemnify & hold harmless the Horse Park at Woodside, its landlord, directors, officers, agents and employees for and against any and all claims, damages, losses, expenses and liabilities of every kind, including but not limited to attorney's fees, in any way arising out of or in connection with my activities under this Agreement. This indemnify shall apply regardless of any active and/or passive negligent act or omission of the Horse Park at Woodside, its landlord, directors, officers, agents and employees.

I have carefully read this agreement and release and fully understand its contents. I am aware that this is a Release of Liability, a waiver of legal rights and contracts between me and The Horse Park at Woodside. I sign this agreement and liability at my own free will. I further acknowledge that there are no warranties either express of implied, concerning the facilities, events or activities at The Horse Park at Woodside.

These rules are in place to protect the rider, horse, and the integrity of the cross country course. Any violation of HPW rules/policies may result in the revocation of membership and/or removal from the property. Please review the Horse Park website regularly for full rules and policy/rule changes.

General Rules:

• PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY! 10 MPH ON ALL HORSE PARK ROADS!

- Membership is required to use the Horse Park facilities
- All membership types must comply with Horse Park dog policies/rules
- Only Dog Members and Full Members are allowed to bring their dogs to the Horse Park
- Helmets required for anyone 18 or under (regardless of riding style)
- No jumping allowed without helmets (regardless of age)
- No jumping alone anywhere on the property (this includes arenas)
- No unattended or loose horses no unattended turnouts in the Round Pen!
- No unattended or loose dogs in barn areas or arenas.
- All injuries and incidents must be reported to the office immediately
- No smoking anywhere on the property
- No open flames, campfires or cooking
- Arenas and cross country course may be closed due to weather conditions
- Drive on designated roads only, NOT on the cross country course!
- Close pasture and other facility gates behind you
- All members and visitors, please clean up after yourself and your horses!
- All members and visitors must show respect and be courteous to others and staff
- Yield to Horse Park staff and equipment
- No Dogs permitted to accompany a rider or riders while riding
- Rider's family, guests, and spectators must stay off course and keep to designated viewing areas.
- Rider's family, guests, and spectators must respect the "NO DOG" policy on the cross country course.
- Show exhibitor's (non-members) are not permitted to use jumps on the cross-country course.

• Dogs **MUST** be leashed, kenneled, housed or tied in barn areas at all times/Dogs are **not** allowed in any arena!

- All riders/trainers must either attain a HPW "Day Use" or "Full" membership with required paperwork and/or insurance certificate (trainers) **PRIOR** to using the facility.
- All "day use" members must check in and pay use fee **BEFORE** using the facility



- Riders, when schooling on the cross country course, **MUST** wear a safety helmet, protective vest, approved medical armband, and be accompanied by a partner over 18 years of age with a cell phone.
- Riders must never jump a "closed" fence or any "closed" section of the cross country course.
- When cross-country course is closed it pertains to all the portions of the course, for all types of riding and driving.
- No unauthorized vehicles permitted on the course.

DOG RULES

Cross-Country Course Hours for Dogs:

Sunrise - 10:00 am & 5:00 pm - Sunset

• Horses/riders always have right of way, including but not limited to: perimeter trails, driveways, roadways, etc...

• Dog members must abide by park hours listed above, specifically related to the interior of the cross-country course area when open and/or related to HPW event schedule.

• When utilizing the perimeter trails it is mandatory to leash your dog when a horse/rider is approaching, no exceptions, even when either member gives 'ok' to pass unleashed.

• No dogs may accompany you while riding or "run alongside" vehicles, including golf carts, motorcycles, etc...

• Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs!

• Dog Members and Full Members may exercise their dogs on the cross country course during designated hours and/or when it is closed to equestrian use.

• Day use members are equestrian members only. They may not utilize the Horse Park for their dogs or other activities.

• Dogs may only be loose in the cross country field if they are under complete voice or aided control at all times. This means dogs cannot be too far ahead or behind a handler that they are unable to respond to commands in the event there is an approaching horse/rider, other dogs, or an emergency.

• Dogs **MUST** be leashed, kenneled, housed or tied in barn areas at all times/Dogs are **not** allowed in any arena!

• No "Professional Dog Walkers" permitted on grounds.

• HPW practices a "no tolerance" policy as it relates to aggressive, disobedient, mismanaged, and/or mishandled dogs.

Violations

Please report any infractions of these rules by fellow members, boarders, trainers, or staff to the Horse Park office immediately.

Any violation of HPW rules/policies may result in the revocation of membership and/or removal from the property!



Emergencies

Please immediately notify the Horse Park Office or a Horse Park office employee. If the Office is closed or no one is available, please use a Cellular Telephone to summon help by dialing 911. The Horse Park is located at 3674 Sand Hill Road in Woodside, San Mateo County, California. Updates on activities and facility conditions are available on the website or by calling the Horse Park office at (650) 851.2140 during regular business hours. You may check status on and enter any Horse Park managed clinic, show or event, renew your membership or make a donation online.

Entrance Gate Access Procedure/Hours

Gates will automatically open/close as each vehicle enters and exits during regular business hours. Between 8:00pm - 6:00am accesses to the park will be for **Emergency Only** and will require an access code. Only full-service boarders and resident trainers will have access to the access code. The code **cannot** be transferred to anyone other than the assignee!

I acknowledge that I have read and understand the Horse Park rules listed above. Furthermore I agree to comply with all rules and policies, and I am aware that I am responsible for following all rule/policy updates as they become available on the Horse Park website. I understand that violation of the Rules may result in removal from the property and the revocation of my membership to the Horse Park.
